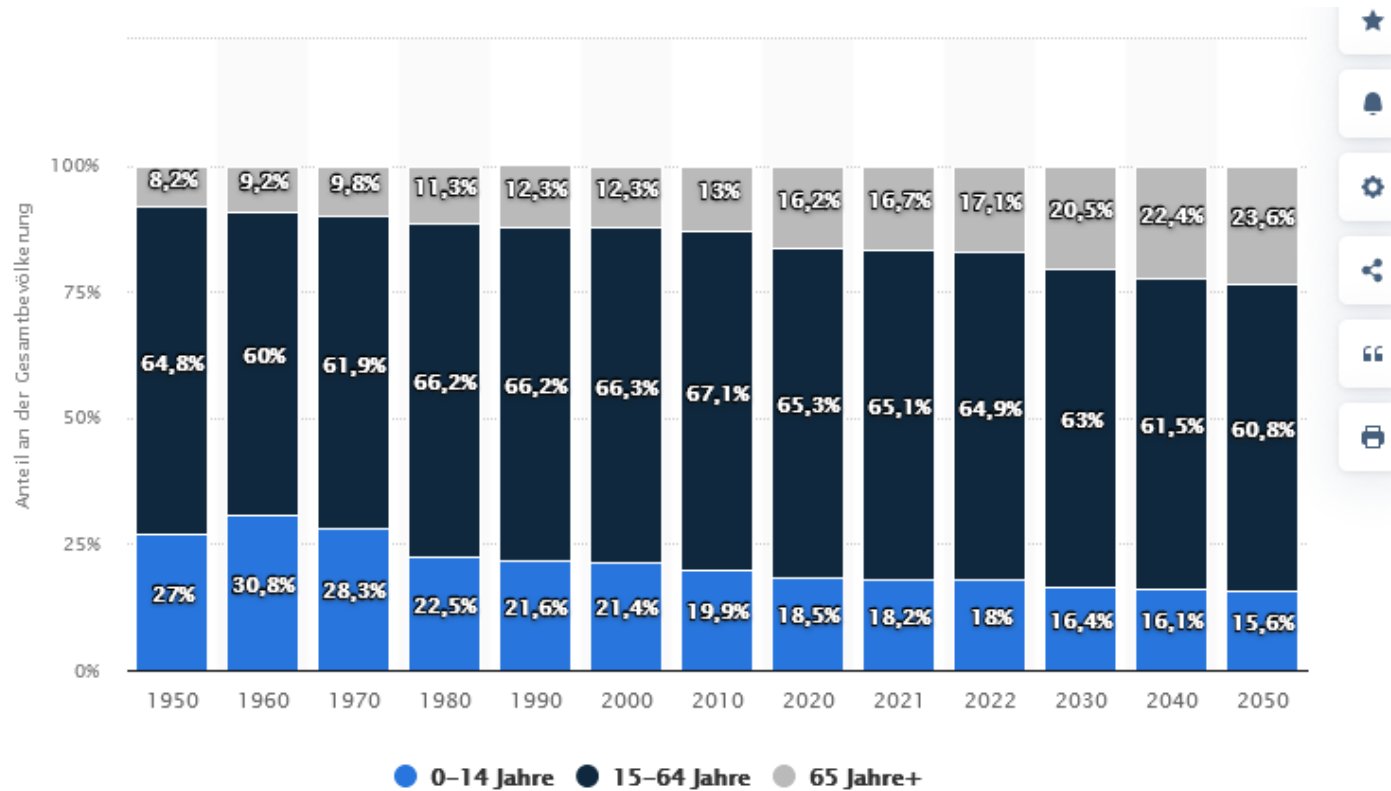

- USA: Age structure from 1950 to 2021 and forecasts to 2050

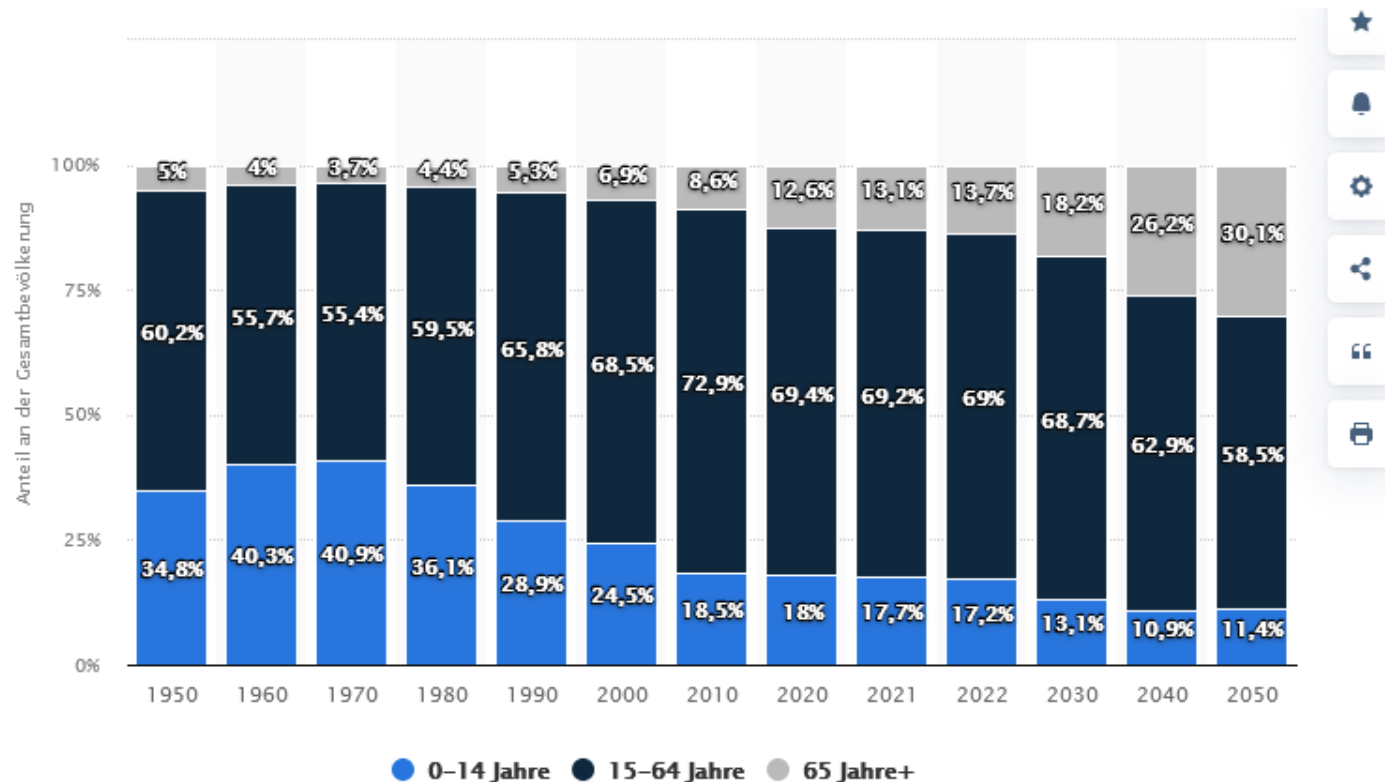

- China: Age structure from 1950 to 2021 and forecasts to 2050

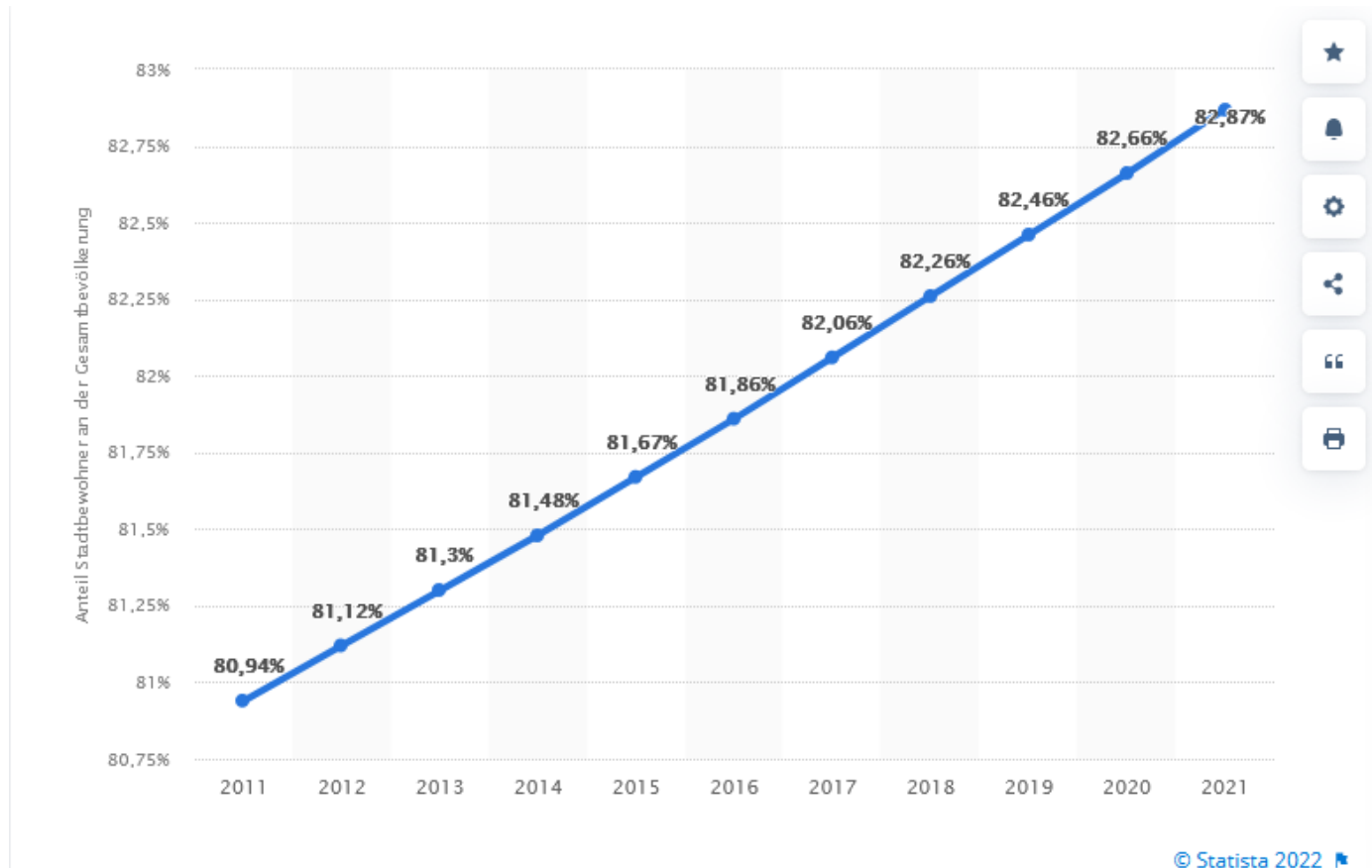

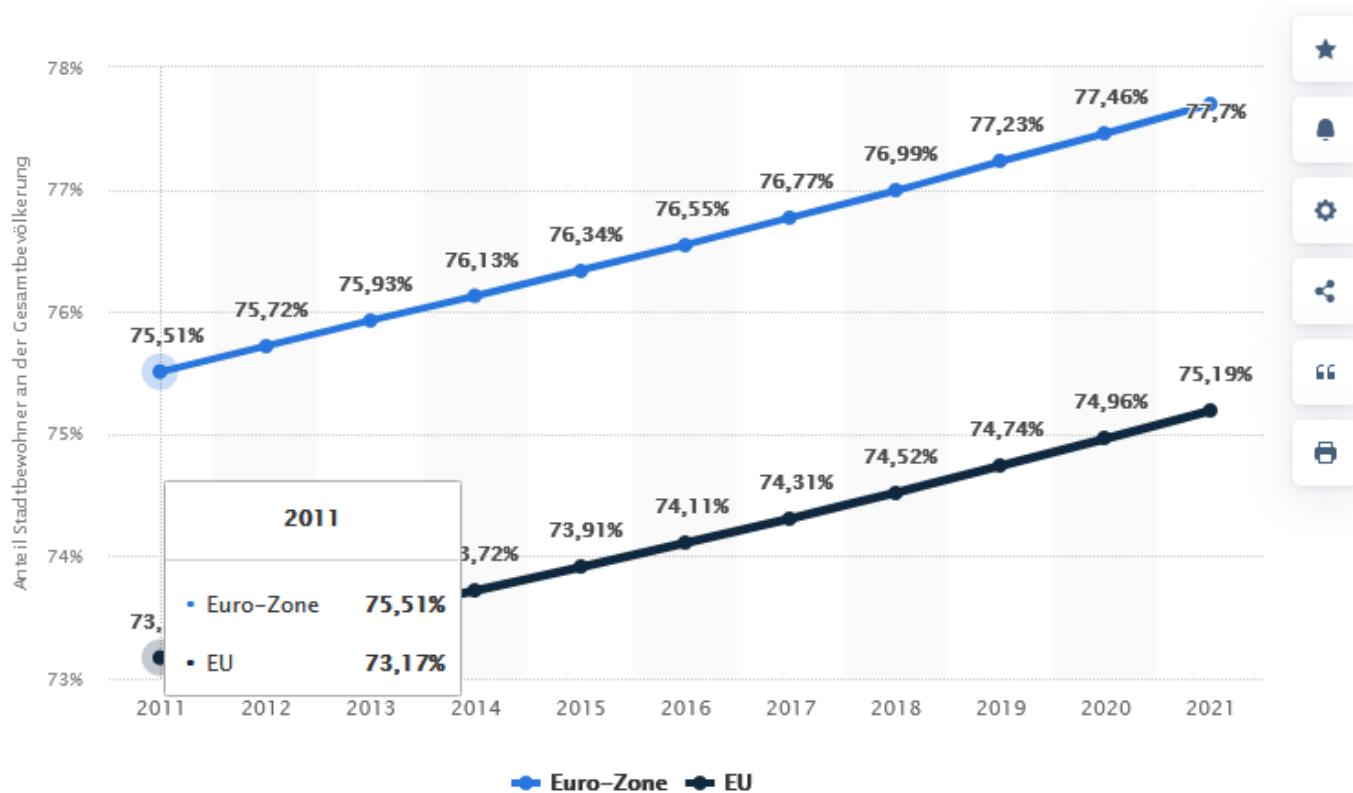
- USA: Degree of urbanisation from 2011 to 2021

- European Union & Eurozone: Urbanisation rate from 2011 to 2021



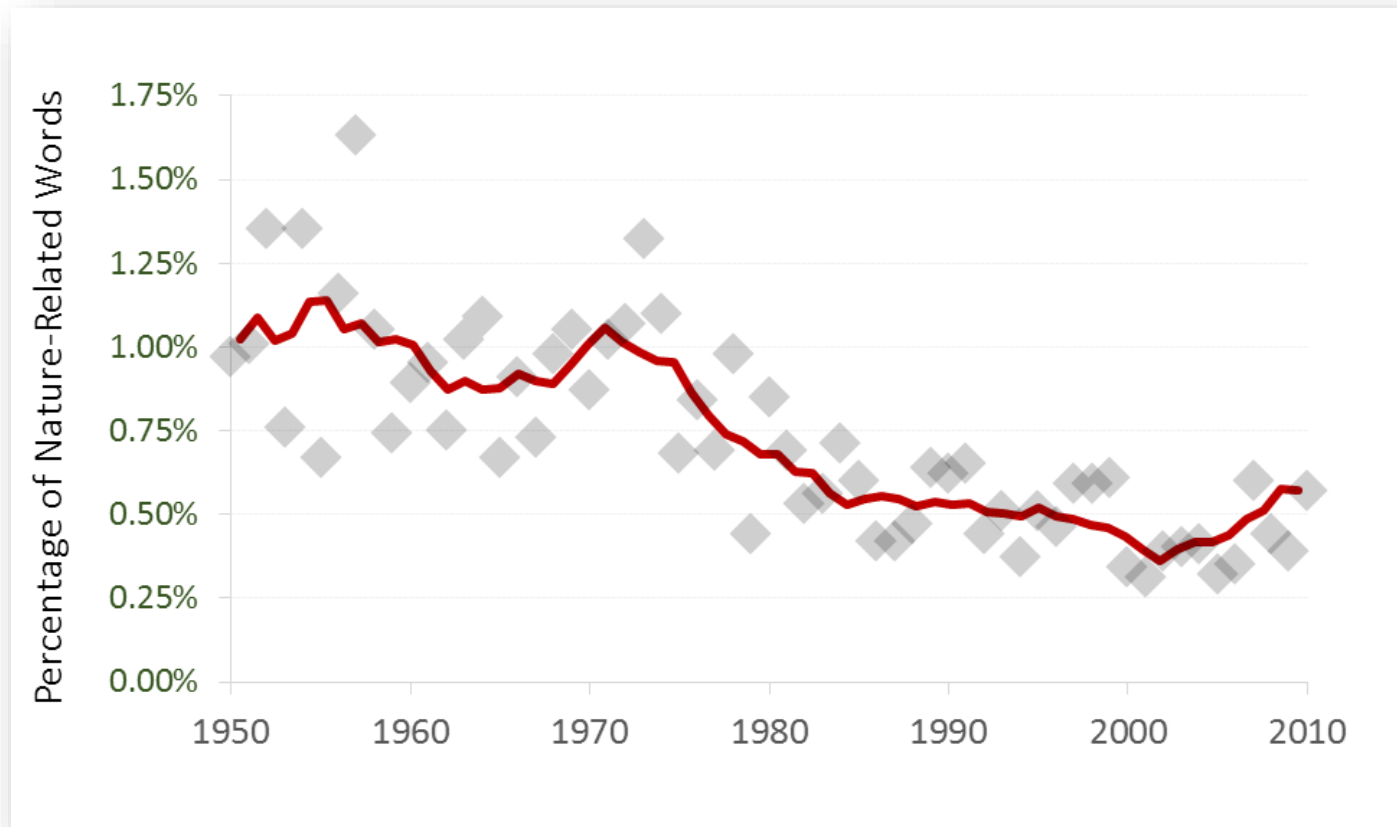

- ... is able to consume news, images and events almost in real-time at any time and place

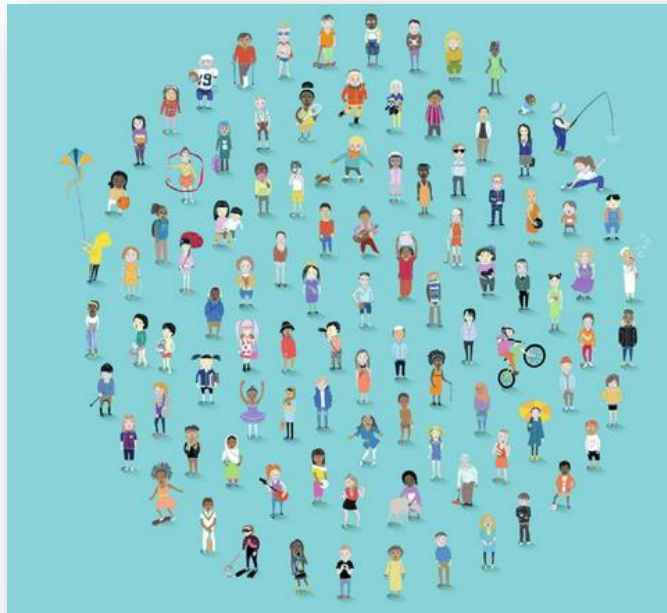

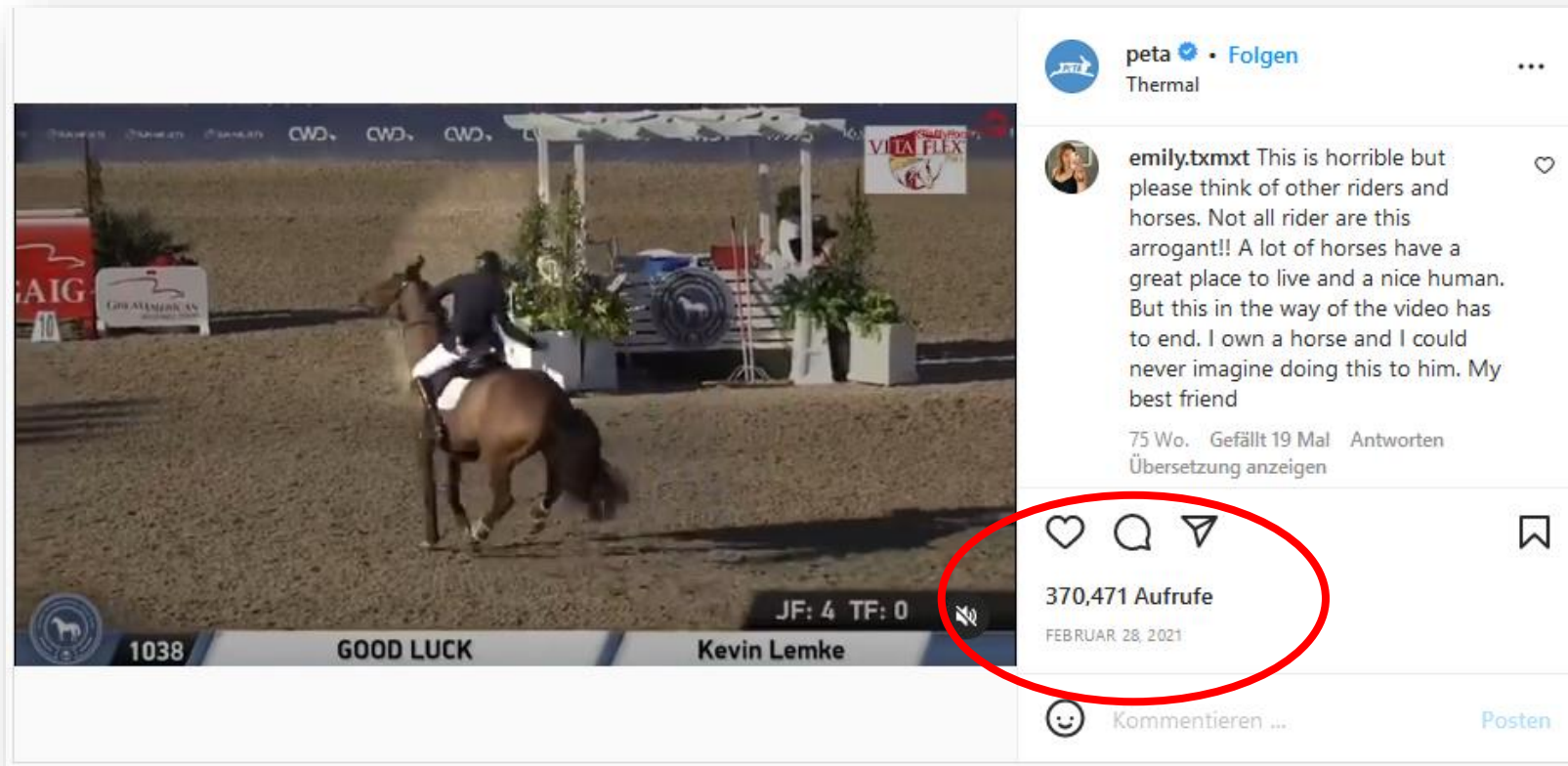

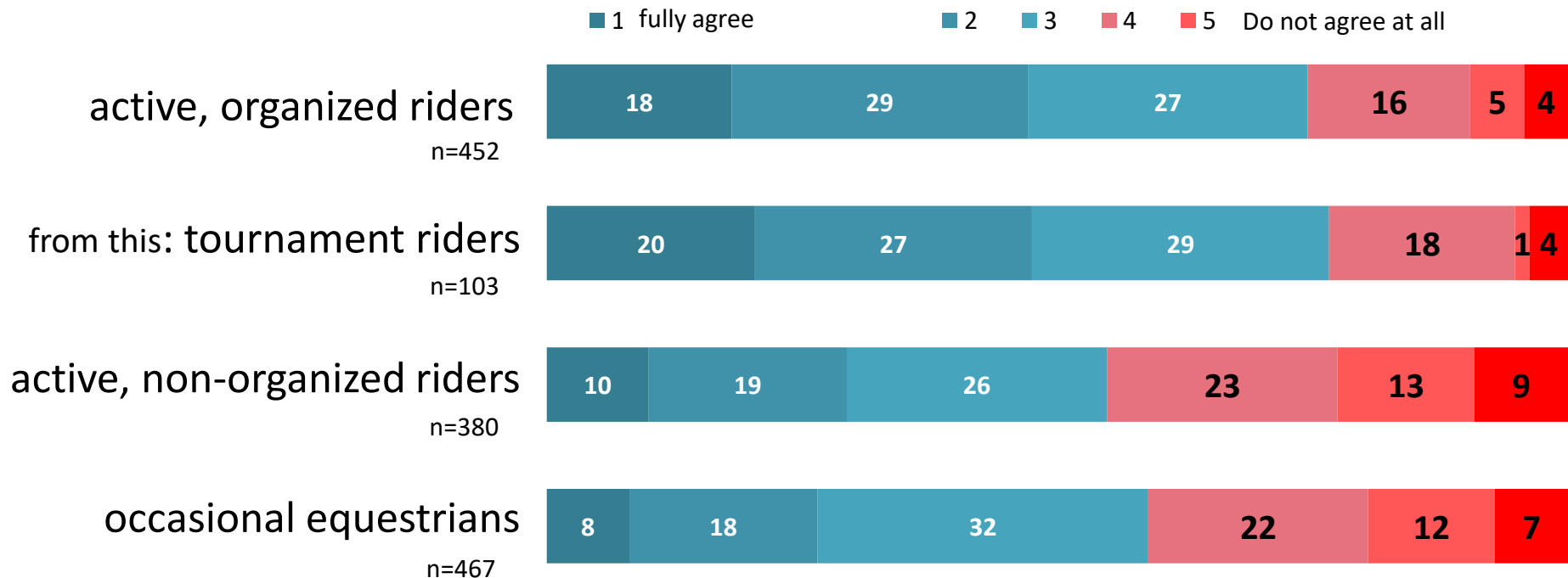

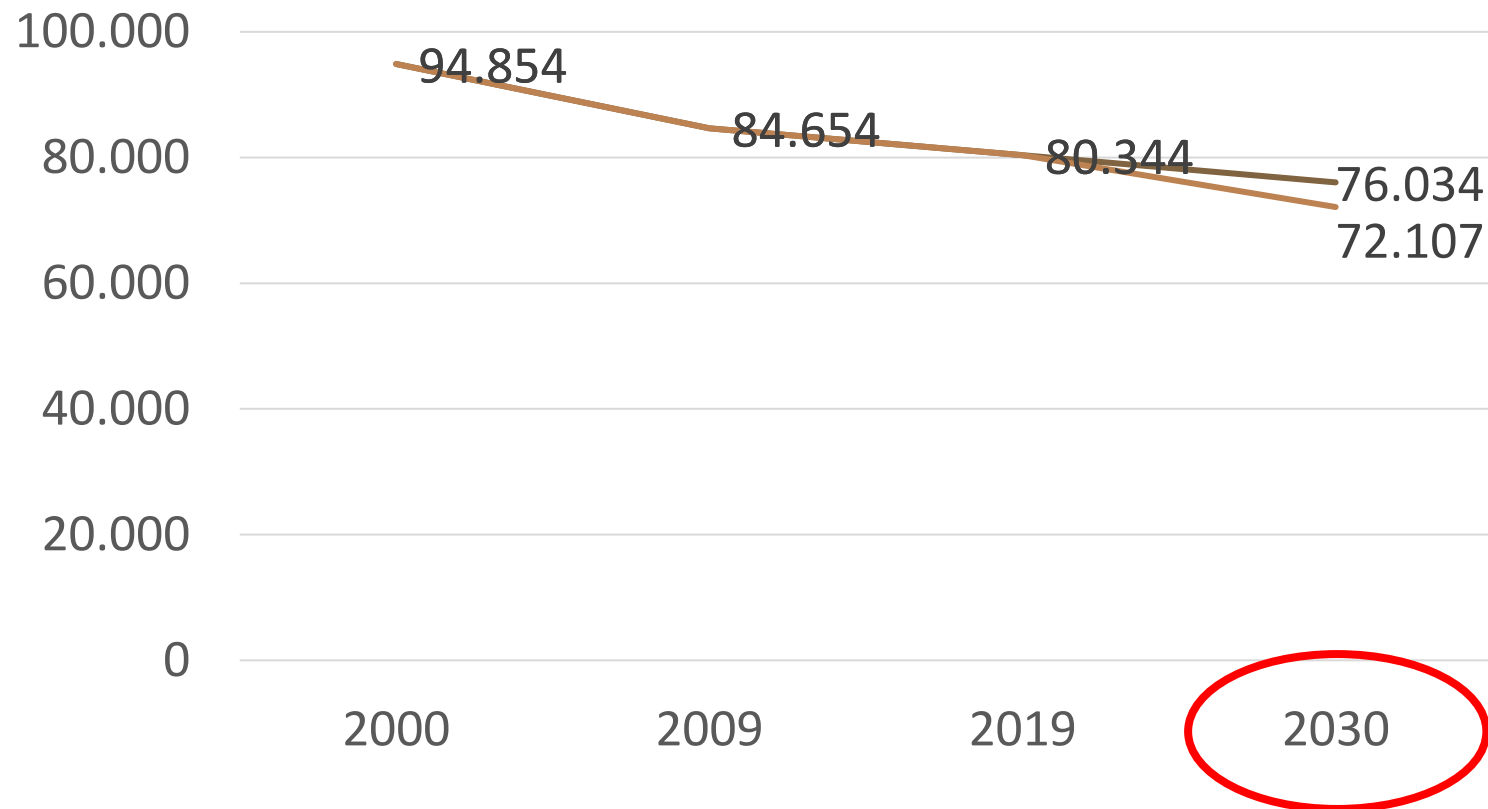

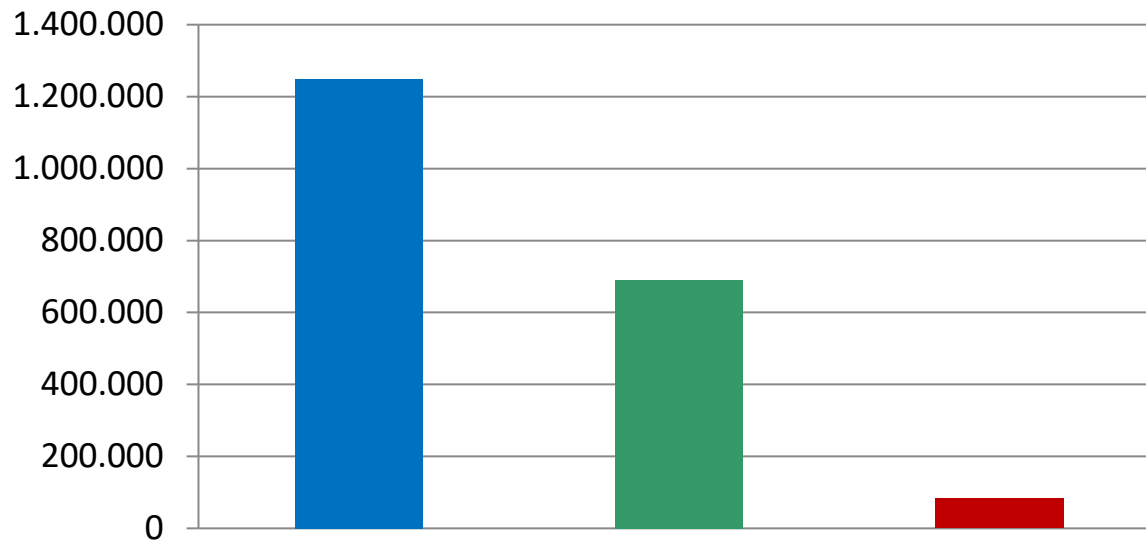

The horse has two sides in the perception of German society.

*One side is the **brutal decline of equestrian sports** (e.g. harness racing, which has been completely replaced by soccer).*

*The other side is the **growing importance of the motive leisure and horses**.
The horse is recognized as an important leisure partner and equestrian sports represent an important hobby in society.*

 - different personal breeding goals
 - especially different importance of the breeding goal sport performance
 - different levels of involvement in the association's activities
 - different opinions on selection and performance testing

Some examples - Member survey Hanoverian Association 2021

■ Long-term members

- Wish for support in sale of horses
- Give more importance to the suitability of a horse for top sport
- Want to preserve their mare line for generations and sell horses profitably
- take part in broodmare tests with their horses
- Go to breeders meetings

■ New members

- Want to breed a horse for themselves or their family
- Want to realize a childhood dream
- Breed with former riding horses of the family or purchased breeding horses
- attend broodmare tests less
- go less to meetings and gatherings

top sport is becoming more and more distant from the base

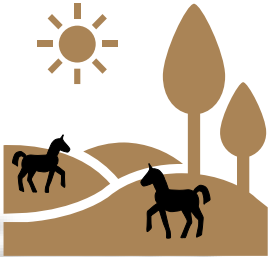


those outside the sector decide what is animal-friendly and what is not



the shortage of skilled workers has speeded up structural change in the equine industry

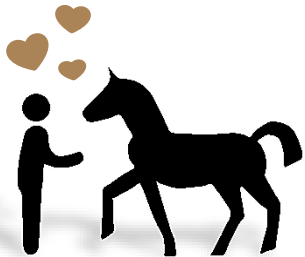
The people of Saxony have a positive attitude towards the horse!
